SLT Minutes December 14, 2021

Corben and Sue surprised us with supper as a thank you for covering for them while at Couples Retreat but also to spend a little time together before we leave for various holiday gatherings with our families. At the end of the evening they presented a demitasse mug created by Mark Nafziger to each of us. We closed the evening celebrating the Lord's Supper together. It was a very meaningful way to end the last meeting of the year 2021.

The SLT met to review information regarding the relationship between Ohio Mennonite Conference and Mennonite Church USA. We would like to plan a time for the congregation to hear more information and to learn about opportunities to engage the process. Dick Barrett, OMC Conference Minister, has offered to come to congregations to review the history of the denomination and summarize recent information. We plan to invite Dick to come to Zion in February, prior to the Annual Conference Assembly being held in March here at Zion.

Sue informed us she is continuing to move forward with the ordination process. The next step is a full psychological profile and gifts assessment required by the Conference for ordination candidates. This has been scheduled for the end of January. A couple weeks later she will have a follow-up meeting to review the results.

In January both Corben and Sue will be gone January 28th thru the 30th. The SLT will look into finding a guest preacher for that Sunday.

On Sunday December 12th, Lonnie Short and Suz Wirick were available in the church office for congregants to comment on the issues of Baptism and Membership. There were no responses. It was decided to announce at the beginning of the service on December 19th that Greg Nofziger and Mike Zimmerman will be available in the office for anyone who would still like to ask questions or make comments.

We decided for the year 2022 the SLT will meet on the second Monday of each month from 4:30-6:00pm.

The SLT has been trying to set up a retreat to seek a clear direction for the Spiritual Leadership Team as we move forward. We are proposing a retreat for Saturday March 19, 2022 at the Rufenacht Cabin.
