...but never the last word

How do you feel about silence? Do you sometimes long for silence and yet find yourself resisting it?

Many writers about discipleship (also called spiritual formation) describe silence as crucial for the spiritual life. In my experience, silence can be hard to find. Even if my surroundings are quiet and I am not speaking, I have so many thoughts and feelings running around inside me that it's a very noisy silence.

Sometimes carefully crafted words express what I would have trouble putting into words. Ted Loder, is retired United Methodist pastor, has offered prayers that nurture my soul as I seek to follow Jesus. Here is a prayer from his 1984 book provocatively titled Guerrillas of Grace:

O Holy One, I hear and say so many words O Holy One,

I hear and say so many words, yet yours is the Word I need. Speak now, and help me listen; and if what I hear is silence, let it quiet me, let it disturb me, let it touch my need, let it break my pride, let it shrink my certainties, let it enlarge my wonder.
