#### **Book Nook**

<u>New Children's books</u>: *Sparking Peace* by Pecinovsky and Martin at Herald Press. This book tells how a junkyard is changed into a garden and also shows how a blacksmith makes a garden tool. This can spark discussions about gun violence and peacemaking. *Stitched Together* by Reid and Cosgrove at Anabaptism at Five Hundred– Herald Press Book - this book tells us where every stitch is a story waiting to be shared.

<u>Donated book</u>: *The Tears Of Things* by Richard Rohr.
